NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY TAX

Section 12-81. Exemptions. The following-described property shall be exempt from taxation:

(53) Motor Vehicle of serviceman. (a) One passenger motor vehicle to, or held in trust for, any member of the United States armed forces, if such motor vehicle is garaged outside the state; (b) Any person claiming the exemption provided under this subdivision for any assessment year shall, not later than the thirty-first day of December next following the date on which property tax is due in such assessment year, file with the assessor or board of assessors, in the town in which such motor vehicle is registered, written application claiming such exemption on a form approved for such purpose by such assessor or board. Failure to file such application as prescribed herein with respect to any assessment year shall constitute a waiver of the right to such exemption for such assessment year.
