## SPECIAL ORDER VETERAN PLATE APPLICATION

1. Plate requests must be for vehicles owned or leased by an honorably discharged Veteran or the surviving spouse of such veteran or an active duty member of the armed forces. A copy of your Certificate Of Release Or Discharge From Active Duty (Form DD 214) or a copy of the United States Uniformed Services ID must be submitted with this application.
2. Plate requests must be made for a vehicle currently registered in Connecticut. (Applications for vehicles currently registered with Temporary plates will not be accepted).
3. You may only acquire the same registration type as you currently have on your vehicle. (Example: If your vehicle is currently registered with Passenger or Handicapped plate types, you can only request a Passenger or Handicapped plate NOT a Commercial or Combination plate.

1. For a Vanity Plate (Specific number or letter combination): A. Complete Sections 1,2,3 and 4 .
B. Place a check mark in the area indicating NEW VANITY PLATE.

B. Place a check mark in the area indicating the plate you wish to obtain.
