The certification must be filed on November 15th biennially thereafter.

FILING THIS CERTIFICATION WILL RESULT IN YOUR COMMITTEE BEING PLACED ON THE LIST OF COMMITTEES WHICH ARE PROHIBITED FROM MAKING OR SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS DURING THE LEGISLATIVE SESSION TO OR FOR ANY CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO A STATEWIDE OFFICE OR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND ANY POLITICAL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY OR ON BEHALF OF, OR CONTROLLED BY, AN ELECTED STATE OFFICER OR GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEMBER, OR HIS AGENT.

THE POLITICAL COMMITTEES WHICH ARE PROHIBITED FROM RECEIVING SUCH CONTRIBUTIONS APPEAR ON THE LIST PREPARED BY THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION.

FAILURE TO FILE THE REQUIRED CERTIFICATION WILL SUBJECT THE VIOLATOR TO THE IMPOSITION OF CIVIL OR CRIMINAL PENALTIES. SEE REVERSE SIDE FOR DEFINITIONS OF THE TERMS USED ON THIS FORM.

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DEFINITIONS

"Lobbyist" means a person who is registered or is required to be registered with the State Ethics Commission as a lobbyist as defined in subsection (1) of Section 1-91, General Statutes.

"Statewide Officer" means the office of governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of the state, comptroller, treasurer or attorney general.

"General Assembly" means state senator or state representative.

"Political committee established by or on behalf of a registered lobbyist" means a political committee for which a lobbyist is an officer or treasurer, or which was created in consultation with, or at the request or suggestion of, a lobbyist or his agent, or is presently controlled by a lobbyist or his agent. Such political committee must also indicate whether they are so established on their Political Committee (PAC) Registration (**SEEC Form 3**).
