## INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT FORM SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS, GENDER AND BIRTH DATE(S)

This form is required by the Nebraska Supreme Court. You should file this document when you file your case for divorce, legal separation, paternity, or child support. The information is confidential and shall not be made part of the case file. This information will be used by the Child Support Division of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, but will not be used for other purposes unless the Court orders it.

## HEADING

- Enter name of the county where the original divorce, legal separation, paternity, or other child support action was filed.
- Enter the first, middle, and last names of the person who was listed as the plaintiff in the original action.
- Enter the first, middle, and last names of the person who was listed as the defendant in the original action
- The Clerk of the District Court assigned a case number when the original action was filed. You must include that case number on any papers you file.

## **BODY OF FORM**

Enter the information requested by the heading of each column for the plaintiff, defendant, and all minor children.
