# ND-1V Individual Electronic Return Payment Voucher

## What is Form ND-1V?

If you file an electronic North Dakota return with a balance due, complete this voucher and submit it with your payment. **Do Not** send a paper copy of your income tax return with your payment; only submit Form ND-1V and your payment.

**Do not use Form ND-1V to make an extension payment.** Extension payments should be made using the extension payment voucher, Form ND-1EXT.

**Do not use Form ND-1V if you pay your balance due using your credit card.**

## When is the payment due?

Form ND-1V and your payment must be postmarked on or before April 15, 2011, to avoid any late payment penalty or interest. This applies even if you have not received acknowledgement that your electronic North Dakota return was accepted.

Credit card payments may be made by telephone or over the Internet through Link2Gov Corporation, a private credit card payment service provider. Link2Gov will charge a convenience fee to your credit card. This fee is retained by the corporation for its services—the State of North Dakota does not receive any part of this fee.
