All correspondence must include the following information: Full name, date of birth, driver license number and state, current mailing address, home and daytime telephone numbers, date and county of arrest, arresting agency, arresting officer, whether the test was failed, or refused, and such other information as requested by the Department. Please specify if you wish to have your hearing by telephone or in person. The request for hearing must be received by the Texas Department of Public Safety no later than 15 days after you receive or are presumed to have received notice of suspension. Failure to request a hearing within this time is a waiver of your right to a hearing. You will be notified of the date, time, and location of your hearing. You will be required to pay a \$125 reinstatement fee to the Texas Department of Public Safety, Driver Improvement Bureau, PO Box 15999, Austin, Texas 78761-5999, in addition to any other fees required by law.
