ORDER MODIFYING OPINION
[CHANGE IN JUDGMENT]

THE COURT*

It is ordered that the opinion filed on April 14, 2004, be modified in the following particulars:

1. On page 2, the last sentence of the first paragraph, is modified to read:

We reverse with directions to the trial court to grant the motion to exclude evidence relevant solely to the entrapment by estoppel defense and to refuse instructions based on that defense.

2. On page 10, the fourth sentence of the first paragraph is modified to read:

*EPSTEIN, Acting P.J., HASTINGS, J., CURRY, J.

In *Raley v. Ohio* (1959) 360 U.S. 423, the chairman of the Ohio Un-American Activities Commission told four people being questioned by the Commission that they had a right to rely on a state constitutional privilege against self-incrimination.

3. On page 15, the disposition is modified to read:

The order of dismissal is reversed. The trial court is directed to enter a new order granting the People's motion to exclude evidence relevant to the defense of entrapment by estoppel and to refuse jury instructions based on that defense.

There is a change in the judgment.
