ORDER MODIFYING OPINION
AND DENYING PETITION
FOR REHEARING; NO CHANGE
IN JUDGMENT

IT IS ORDERED that the opinion filed herein on January 31, 2003, be modified as follows:

1. On page 2, in the fourth full paragraph, delete the third sentence and replace it with the following sentence:

The complaint also alleged defendant inflicted serious bodily injury, and had a 1995 conviction for felony assault, a prior serious felony within the meaning of the “Three Strikes” law and section 667.5, subdivision (a), a 1995 conviction for felony false imprisonment, and had served a prior prison term, pursuant to section 667.5, subdivision (b).

The petition for rehearing is DENIED. This modification does not effect a change in the judgment.
