PER CURIAM.

We have for review <u>Manos v. State</u>, 895 So. 2d 524 (Fla. 5th DCA 2005), in which the Fifth District Court of Appeal cited as authority <u>Franklin v. State</u>, 877 So. 2d 19 (Fla. 4th DCA 2004), <u>quashed</u>, 955 So. 2d 564 (Fla. 2007). At the time the Fifth District Court issued its decision in <u>Manos</u>, <u>Franklin</u> was pending review in this Court. We have jurisdiction. <u>See</u> art. V, § 3(b)(3), Fla. Const.; <u>Jollie v.</u> <u>State</u>, 405 So. 2d 418 (Fla. 1981).

We stayed proceedings in this case pending disposition of <u>Franklin</u>. We ultimately quashed the Fourth District Court's underlying <u>Franklin</u> decision. <u>See</u> <u>State v. Franklin</u>, 955 So. 2d 564 (Fla. 2007) (citing <u>Sanders v. State</u>, 944 So. 2d

203 (Fla. 2006)). Having disposed of <u>Franklin</u>, we then issued an order directing respondent to show cause why we should not accept jurisdiction in the present case, quash the <u>Manos</u> decision, and remand for reconsideration in light of our decision in <u>Franklin</u>. Upon consideration of respondent's response and the parties' previously filed jurisdictional briefs, we have determined to so proceed.

We grant the petition for review in the present case, quash the decision under review, and remand this matter to the Fifth District Court of Appeal for reconsideration upon application of this Court's decision in <u>Franklin</u>.

It is so ordered.
