PER CURIAM.

We have for review <u>Citizens Property Insurance Corp. v. Dancy</u>, 963 So. 2d 271 (Fla. 1st DCA 2007), in which the First District Court of Appeal cited as authority its decision in <u>Florida Farm Bureau Casualty Insurance Co. v. Cox</u>, 943 So. 2d 823 (Fla. 1st DCA 2006), <u>quashed</u>, 967 So. 2d 815 (Fla. 2007). At the time the First District issued its decision in <u>Dancy</u>, <u>Cox</u> was pending review in this Court. We have jurisdiction. <u>See</u> art. V, § 3(b)(3), Fla. Const.; <u>Jollie v. State</u>, 405 So. 2d 418 (Fla. 1981).

We ultimately quashed the First District's underlying <u>Cox</u> decision. <u>See Fla.</u> <u>Farm Bureau Cas. Ins. Co. v. Cox</u>, 967 So. 2d 815 (Fla. 2007). We accordingly issued an order directing respondent to show cause why this Court should not accept jurisdiction in the present case, quash the <u>Dancy</u> decision under review, and remand for reconsideration in light of our decision in <u>Cox</u>. Upon consideration of respondent's response and petitioner's reply thereto, we have determined to so proceed.

We thus grant the petition for review in the present case. The decision under review is quashed, and this matter is remanded to the First District Court of Appeal for reconsideration upon application of this Court's decision in <u>Cox</u>. Respondent's pending motion for appellate attorney fees is hereby denied.

It is so ordered.
