## CARTER, C.J.

Plaintiff/Appellant, Edward Simmons, an inmate in the custody of the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, filed a petition for judicial review of a final agency decision rendered under the Corrections Administrative Remedy Procedure Act.<sup>1</sup>

novo review and in accordance with the Following de Commissioner's recommendation, the district court dismissed plaintiff's Simmons appeals. After petition for judicial review with prejudice. considering the record, we conclude that Simmons is not entitled to relief under LSA-R.S. 15:1177A(9), and we agree with the district court's conclusion that Simmons's petition for judicial review should be dismissed with prejudice. Finding the Commissioner's Recommendation adequately explains the decision of this court, we affirm the district court's judgment by summary disposition in accordance with Rule 2-16.2A(5) of the Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal. Costs of this appeal are assessed to plaintiff/appellant, Edward Simmons.
